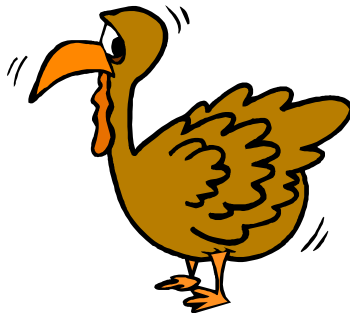

## Sherwood Memorial Hall Fundraiser A Big Success

On September 9th, the City of Sherwood and the American Legion sponsored a fundraiser to raise enough money to keep the Sherwood Memorial Hall open for the winter. The American Legion has been taking care of the hall for years with funds they get from gaming. With the flooding of the Mouse River Park, a large amount of revenue has been lost.

Approximately 250 people showed up the night of September 9th for the event. There was free food including corn on the cob, hamburgers, brats, beans, and chips. The corn was donated by Jim and Lana Southam, and the food was donated by Nettie Daeley.

There were silent auctions for pies baked by ladies of the community, homemade jams and relishes by Wendy Solemsaas, a wine basket by Elaine Roberts, and also a silent auction for a new rifle donated by Dwight Knutson. The city of Sherwood donated a 42" HDTV, the American Legion Auxiliary donated 3 custom made birthday cakes baked by Anita Knutson, and the Sherwood Masons donated a picture that we sold raffle tickets on.

The people of Sherwood and the area responded to our need for money, and up to this point we have collected \$17,800 that has been deposited into the hall fund. There were several businesses and individuals that made large contributions. Whether you gave a little or a lot, every dollar collected is much appreciated. This should be enough money to operate the Memorial Hall until we are able to resume normal gaming operations.
