Sherwood Memorial Hall Needs Your Help

Back in the early 1950s, a group of Sherwood residents got together and built the Memorial Hall on Main Street in Sherwood. The American Legion has pretty much been the guardian of the hall over the years. The school helped out with expenses while they played basketball there until the late 1960s.

The Memorial Hall has been the center of activity in Sherwood for over 60 years, and we certainly don't want to close it down for the winter.

The cost to operate the hall has risen dramatically over the years with the increase in the price of fuels. The American Legion began charitable gaming a few years ago to help pay for expenses. With the revenue we got from the Mouse River Park gaming, we were able to stick quite a bit of money into the hall fund to tide us over the winter and into the next year. This year with the loss of all revenue from the Mouse River Park and the decrease in revenue from gaming, we will not have enough money to operate the hall this winter. With that gaming revenue, we were not able to finance hall expenses, but also gave hundreds of thousands of dollars in grants and scholarships to the entire area. Tonight, we will have a fundraiser at the Memorial Hall in the hopes that the people of Sherwood and the surrounding area can help us until we're able to re-establish gaming at the Mouse River Park.

We're going to have a big celebration at the hall with corn on the cob, hamburgers, hot dogs, brats, and beans. Come on up and have supper. There will be a free-will offering and even if you can't give a lot, come up and enjoy the meal. There will be lots of raffles and a pie auction. All revenue tonight will go directly into the Hall Fund.

September 15, 2011 Marks 20th Anniversary of Fireman Accident



On September 15th, 1991 the Sherwood Fire Department responded to an oil fire 12 miles west of Sherwood. Eight fireman; Tim Schneiderman, Brad Johnson, David Steeves, Wayne Stanley, Bob Steeves, and John Daeley were injured that night. Craig Keith and Kevin Johnson lost their lives.

As time passes on, our minds tend to forget tragedy of our past. I remember vaguely the details of this accident. It was the night of the homecoming dance and I was a sophomore in Sherwood. I remember the following days at school; the counselors, the teachers trying to help the kids fully grasp what had happened to our small community. Some lost a close friend, others lost a son, brother, father, husband. Some were scarred physically and emotionally that night. We all lost a part of our community that was changed without measure that night.

Share with your kids the importance of this date and the sacrifices these volunteers and their families made.

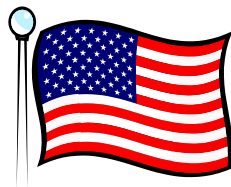
Please take the opportunity to remember and even thank those who had their lives altered because they wanted to keep the people of this community safe.
