**MLS-SHERWOOD STUDENTS
SUBMIT ARTWORK**

Wyatt Stanley & Alexis Krause have had their artwork accepted by the N.D. Student Juried Art Show. Any student who is currently attending a North Dakota school was eligible to submit their original artwork by the April 1 deadline. Artwork chosen for awards being sponsored by Gov. Hoeven, Senator Dorgan, Senator Conrad, and Representative Pomeroy will be displayed in their Washington & N.D. offices and also the U.S. Capitol. The governor signs a Certificate of Artistic Excellence for each student whose work is selected for each of the award categories and the traveling exhibit. The Taube Museum faculty selects one piece from the traveling show, to be matted and framed, prior to the return to the student. Jurors will select an additional 80 pieces from all categories for a traveling exhibit that travels to Galleries and Schools around the state. The Exhibit will be on display at the Lillian and Coleman Taube Museum of Art, 2 North Main St. Minot, ND; through the end of April and will also be on display at the ND State Fair in July. Support for this activity comes in part from the ND Council on the Arts.
